



DROP-OFF LOCATIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE, APPLIANCES AND ELECTRONICS FROM TYPHOON CLEANUP



The CNMI Bureau of Environmental and Coastal Quality and the US Environmental Protection Agency are accepting household hazardous waste and white goods generated **as part of the cleanup from Typhoon Soudelor.**

Household Hazardous Waste is:

- **CLEANERS** (such as bleach and ammonia)
- **ROACH & OTHER PEST KILLERS**
- **PAINT & WORKSHOP SUPPLIES**
- **AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTS**
- **FLAMMABLE PRODUCTS** (such as oil, gas and propane)
- **LAWN & GARDEN PRODUCTS**
- **OTHER HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS**
- **FLUORESCENT LIGHTS**
- **THERMOMETERS**
- **BATTERIES**

White Goods include:

- **AIR CONDITIONERS**
- **REFRIGERATORS and FREEZERS**
- **STOVES AND OVENS**
- **MICROWAVE OVENS**
- **WASHERS AND DRYERS**
- **WATER HEATERS**
- *Televisions, computers and other electronics*

You must bring all items to a drop-off location. Do not place items in a ditch or on the road.
