- Section 3. **Territorial Sea.** Conveyance of submerged lands to the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
- Section 4. **Minimum Wage Adjustment in the Northern Mariana Islands.** Adjustment of the frequency of mandated increases.
- Section 5. **Amendments to the Consolidated Natural Resources Act:**
- a) Extensions of the Commonwealth-Only Transitional Worker and Investor (E2-CNMI) programs until 2019.
 - b) Accountability of the \$150 supplemental training fee.
- Section 6. **Empowering Insular Communities.** Require the Secretary of the Interior to assemble a team of technical, policy, and financial experts to address the energy needs of the insular areas of the United States.
- Section 7. **Chief Financial Officer of the Virgin Islands.** To provide for a popular referendum regarding the creation of the Office of Chief Financial Officer of the Government of the Virgin Islands, and setting out the method of appointment and responsibilities of such Office, if approved.
- Section 8. **LIHEAP Assistance.** Increases the number of Virgin Islands households eligible for low-income energy assistance from the current fiscal year through FY2018.
- Section 9. **Castle Nugent National Historic Site.** Establishes the Castle Nugent National Historic Site on the island of St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands, as a unit of the National Park System.
- Section 10. **St. Croix National Heritage Area.** Establishes the St. Croix National Heritage Area in St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Section 11. **Guam World War II Loyalty Recognition Act.** Implements the findings of the Guam War Claims Review Commission by ensuring that there is parity in the payment of war reparations to the loyal people of Guam who endured a brutal enemy occupation.
- Section 12. **Prioritization of U.S. Citizens and Nationals in HUD assistance programs.** Ensures that American citizens and nationals have priority over non-resident aliens for access to public housing and other assistance programs.

- Section 13. **Benefit-to-cost Ratio Formulas for Projects in American Samoa.** Directs the Comptroller General to conduct a study regarding the use of benefit-to-cost ratio formulas by federal departments and agencies.
- Section 14. **Adjustment of Local Matching Requirements.** Adjusts the amount waived by each federal granting agency for local matching funds required of a Territory.
- Section 15. **Fishery Endorsement Adjustment for U.S. tuna purse seine vessels that offload in American Samoa.** Modifies fishery endorsement for U.S. tuna purse seine vessels that offload in American Samoa but were rebuilt outside of the United States before January 1, 2011.
- Section 16. **Recommendation for Minimum Wage in American Samoa.** Authorizes the Comptroller General of the United States to include an analysis of the economic effects on employees and employers of the differentials in minimum wage rates among industries and classifications in American Samoa.
- Section 17. **Citizenship Plebiscite for American Samoa.** Directs the Secretary of Interior to conduct a plebiscite in American Samoa on the issue whether persons born in American Samoa desire U.S. citizenship.
- Section 18. **Impact expenditures considered in-kind.** Authorizes “in-kind” expenditures, as determined by the Secretary of the Interior and which affected jurisdictions have provided to the federal government for the support of Compact migrants, to be used to meet local matching requirements for certain federal grant programs.
