

After the President has submitted his budget to Congress, a next step in the annual appropriation process is for individual Members of the House of Representatives to submit their recommendations of programs that should be funded and funding amounts to the Appropriations Committee.

This attached document lists all of the programs I have recommended be funded in fiscal year 2015 and the funding levels I support for each.

You will also find information here about the amount of funding received in the Northern Mariana Islands for each program. There are some programs, for which the Northern Marianas is eligible, for which no funds have been received. These can be competitive programs, which the Commonwealth or individuals have chosen not to participate in or have not successfully competed. Or, in some cases, these are programs which benefit organizations or individuals in the Marianas, but not with direct funding.

Fiscal year 2015 begins on October 1.
