Dear Representative Sablan:

The Army has completed a survey of its installations for their possession of a complete set of ceremonial state and territorial flags, including the flag of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, as directed in Secretary McHugh's December 10, 2010 response to your inquiry.

While most Army installations are now in possession of at least one complete set of state and territorial display flags, there remain a few installations that do not possess a complete or up-to-date set of flags. Specifically, Red Cloud, Casey, Yongsan and Humphreys in Korea do not have up-to-date sets, but have taken steps to remedy the situation. To ensure that necessary actions have occurred, Headquarters, Installation Management Command, published on 27 January, 2011, additional guidance giving installations 31 days from receipt of the guidance to be in full compliance with Army regulations addressing the display of state and territorial flags.

The Army will continue to be vigilant to correct omissions when they occur. We understand the importance of this issue to you and your constituents, and to all other citizens of these United States and Territories.

Thank you again for bringing this to the attention of Army leadership and for your continued support of Army Soldiers and their Families.
